Subject: Preferential Permit Parking Program Expansion of District No. 1

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the City Council adopt a resolution approving the expansion of Preferential Parking District (PPD) No. 1 to include the 6000 blocks of Greenleaf and Washington Avenues and the 13000 through 13300 block of Broadway.

BACKGROUND

At the February 26, 2013, July 9, 2013, September 24, 2013, May 27, 2014, August 12, 2014, October 28, 2014, March 24, 2015, April 28, 2015, and September 8, 2015 meetings the City Council adopted Resolutions Nos. 8524, 8557, 8588, 8627, 8648, 8664, 8683, 8687, and 8727 respectively, creating and/or expanding PPD No. 1 to the area shaded on the attached map (Attachment A). Since September 2015, three additional petitions have been submitted for the 6000 blocks of Greenleaf and Washington Avenues and along the 13000 block of Broadway (Attachment B). The support percentages for the 6000 block of Greenleaf Avenue, Comstock Avenue, and Broadway were 86%, 69%, and 86%, respectively.

At the December 8, 2015 City Council meeting, it was recommended to dissolve PPD No. 2, approve expanding PPD No. 1 to include the 6000 blocks of Greenleaf and Washington Avenues and the 13000 block of Broadway; and consolidate PPD No. 2 into one large district to be renamed PPD No. 1 since both PPD districts were abutting one another. After City Council deliberation and a reluctance to create a larger district at that time, it was directed to return to the City Council in January 2016 to consider the three petitions within the existing PPD No. 1 boundary.

DISCUSSION

The three petitions were reviewed for conformance with Ordinance No. 2997 in that the petition was signed by no less than two-thirds of all property owners of record and/or lawful lessees of properties "comprising all developed frontage of the street...as a preferential parking district." However, subsequent to the publication of the agenda report and posting of the City Council agenda, a resident along the 6000 block of Washington Avenue withdrew their support for preferential permit parking. This lowered the support percentage to 65% which is slightly less than the required 66.7%. However, this reduction is negligible and the consideration to include the 6000 block of Washington Avenue is still recommended. Therefore, it is recommended the City Council adopt the attached proposed resolution to expand the PPD No. 1 boundary to


include the 6000 blocks of Greenleaf and Washington Avenues and the 13000 through 13300 block of Broadway (Attachment C). Affected residents/tenants were notified of the City Council meeting and the intent to expand the district.

FISCAL IMPACT



RESOLUTION NO. ____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 8727 AND ESTABLISHING PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT NO. 1 LOCATED WITHIN BOUNDARIES OF THE STREETS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE THERETO

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Whittier adopted Chapter 10.18 of the Whittier Municipal Code establishing a Preferential Parking Program as authorized by California Vehicle Code Section 22507;

WHEREAS, Chapter 10.18 authorizes the City Council to designate, by resolution, those areas in the City that shall be subject to preferential parking by permit;

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 8524 on February 26, 2013 establishing Preferential Parking District No. 1 for Rose Drive from Greenleaf Avenue to Milton Avenue to be designated as "Preferential Parking District No. 1";

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 8557 on July 9, 2013, Resolution No. 8558 on September 24, 2013, Resolution No. 8627 on May 27, 2014, Resolution No. 8648 on August 12, 2014, Resolution No. 8664 on October 28, 2014, Resolution No. 8683 on March 24, 2015, Resolution No. 8687 on April 28, 2015, and Resolution No. 8727 on September 8, 2015 expanding Preferential Parking District No. 1;

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore determined that several neighborhood streets near Hellman Wilderness Park and Turnbull Canyon Trailhead continue to suffer from a severe shortage of on-street parking for residents; and

WHEREAS, based thereon, it is the intent of the City Council in adopting this Resolution to minimize said problems to provide for more on-street parking for residents by designating said area as a preferential parking district and all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are a substantial part of this resolution.

SECTION 2. Resolution No. 8727 is rescinded and replaced with this resolution to establish an expanded Parking District No. 1 including Rose Drive from Greenleaf Avenue to Milton Avenue, Orange Drive from approximately Panorama Drive to the 5800 block of Friends Avenue, Milton Avenue north of Orange Drive, Milton Place,

Stardell Street, the 5800 block of Bright Avenue, the 5800 block through 6000 block of Washington Avenue, the 5800 block through 6000 block of Comstock Avenue, the 5800 block of Milton Avenue, the north side of Beverly Boulevard between Milton Avenue and Comstock Avenue, the 5800 through 6000 block of Friends Avenue, the 13000 through 13400 block of Beverly Boulevard, the 13000 block through 13300 block of Broadway, the 5800 through 6000 block of Greenleaf Avenue, the 5600 through 5700 block of Newlin Avenue, the 5600 through 5700 block of Panorama Drive, the 12600 through 12700 block of Orange Drive, and abutting affected properties/addresses located within boundaries of the streets and including all adjacent residences which area is hereby designated "Preferential Parking District No. 1" as shown on Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle within the Preferential Parking District No.1 unless such person has been issued a currently valid preferential parking permit for said district pursuant to Chapter 10.18 of the Whittier Municipal Code, and displays said permit at all times within his or her parked vehicle by hanging the same from the interior rear-view mirror, or as otherwise directed by the director of public works.

SECTION 4. Use of a preferential parking permit is subject to all terms and conditions set forth in Chapter 10.18 of the Whittier Municipal Code.

SECTION 5. Permit types. The following are types of permit available:

- (a) Annual residential permit. This permit is valid for the calendar year renewable on December 31, may be renewed, and is only available to residents within the District. Annual residential permits are subject to the prohibition in WMC 10.18.080(c).
- (b) Guest permit. The City Manager may issue guest permits on an annual or temporary basis for use by residents and their guests. Guest permits are not subject to the prohibition in WMC 10.18.080(c) and may be shared among permit holders and their guests.

SECTION 6. Number of Permits. The number of annual residential permits issued per single-family residence shall not exceed one permit for each vehicle with a valid registration issued by the California Department of Motor Vehicles and showing the address of the permit applicant. Temporary guest permits may be issued without limitation on an as-needed basis to residents within the District and shall be valid for one calendar day. No more than three annual guest permits may be issued per residence in the District.

SECTION 7. Permit Filing Fee. There shall be no filing fee for permits in Parking District No. 1, except that replacement annual residential permits and replacement annual guest permits shall each be subject to a \$50 replacement fee.

SECTION 8. The provisions of this resolution shall not become effective unless and until the City has installed signs sufficient to provide notice to persons within

Preferential Parking District No. 1 of the parking restrictions set forth in Section 3 of this resolution.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk-Treasurer shall certify to the passage and adoption hereof.
