

Construction Site Waste Minimalization

Reducing the amount of waste generated at your construction site can result in considerable cost savings. Some waste reduction tips are listed below.

Action Required

- Careful estimating of materials needed for the job.
- Accurate measurements to reduce sawcuts onsite (measure twice, cut once).
- Order pre-engineered materials to reduce cutting materials to size on-site, i.e., steel framing or engineered wood products.
- Reuse materials onsite, such as concrete forming lumber for roof decking or red clay tile roofing.

Results

- Save money by reducing materials purchased.
- Save money from reduced disposal costs and overlimit load fees (typically a \$450 tip fee with a \$150 overlimit surcharge).
- Reduce burdens on local landfill and transportation of materials.
- Positive business image.

Reuse Opportunities and Materials Exchange Programs

Material exchange programs are free services designed to help businesses find markets for materials they have traditionally discarded.


