Lisa joined the City as City Clerk in September 2017. She is Whittier's election official, legislative officer, and Political Reform Act filing officer. She assists all departments with Brown Act (Open Meeting Act) compliance, and is responsible for preservation of City and associated agencies' official records and making those records available to the public. Her department provides 24/7 network and telephone services to all City departments and is responsible for the City's website, fleet of PCs and printers, as well as specialty technology equipment. Current department projects include online permitting and payments, updating the City's website, and implementation of an electronic document management system (EDMS) in preparation for increased on-line access to public records.

Prior to coming to Whittier, Lisa worked for the cities of Moorpark, Malibu and Santa Monica. She has been active in the City Clerk profession serving on the City Clerks Association of California (CCAC) Board as Communications Director, Second Vice President, First Vice President and CCAC President from 2009-2010 and on International Institute of Municipal Clerks and League of California Cities committees.

In March 2008, Lisa obtained the designation of Master Municipal Clerk (MMC). She was an Honored Recipient of the 2005 President's Award of Distinction for Elections Management and was awarded the CCAC City Clerk of the Year award at the 2015 Annual Conference.
