

# Pool Procedures and Rules for Private & School Parties

## Upon Arriving at the Pool

Upon arrival, party's primary contact should check in with the Pool Manager. Group will be instructed to enter through the side gate of the pool and gather at the pool bleacher area for a brief run through of entry procedures and pool rules. All swimmers must shower off in the locker rooms before entering the pool. **Please note that set-up time, locker-room time and clean-up time is included in your rental time. Additional time will not be given for participants to get dressed before or after the event. Rental Group is responsible for monitoring the guests who are entering/exiting the event. It is recommended that wristbands be provided so party guests are easily identified.**

## Pool Rules

1. There must be **one adult for each child** under 48 inches unless the child passes a swim test given by a lifeguard.
2. No running on the pool deck, bleacher area or in the locker rooms at any time
3. Diving is not permitted, except in designated areas. There is No Diving in the shallow end.
4. **Proper swim attire is required.** The following attire is prohibited: Tee-shirts, tank tops, street cloths, cutoffs, pants, jeans, thong bikini bottoms or any other attire the lifeguards deem unsafe or inappropriate. **Infants need to wear approved "swim diapers" to be allowed pool entry.**
5. No floatation devices of any type are allowed in the pool.
6. No food is allowed on the pool deck or in the pool. All food must be kept or eaten in the bleacher area.
7. All personal items must be left on the bleacher area or locked in a locker. No items should be left on the pool deck. Management is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Participants need to provide own lock.
8. No chicken fighting, rough play or any other dangerous practices are allowed at any time.
9. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.
10. Swimmers MUST stay off lane lanes, ropes, safety lines and lifeguard stands.
11. All participants need to obey the Lifeguards at all time and refrain from distracting the Lifeguards while they are on Duty. Failure to do so could result in ejection from the pool or pool deck.
12. No Glass, Alcohol, or Tobacco is permitted anywhere in the pool area. Possession of alcohol will result in immediate cancellation of event without a refund. Smoking is not permitted on the pool deck, bleacher area or locker room area.
13. No animals are allowed in the pool or on the pool deck. Service animals are permitted on the pool deck.
14. Persons with colds, coughs, nasal or eye discharges, skin eruptions, sores or bandages maybe denied entry into pool or pool area for safety reasons.

**\*Failure to comply with any of the above rules may result in expulsion from the pool or pool grounds or the cancellation of the private pool party event without a refund. Refunds will not be given should the pool need to be shut down due to an event caused by one of the participants of the pool party.\***
