

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 12, 2022, DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY THE CITY CHARTER

RECITALS

- A. A General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Whittier, California, on Tuesday, April 12, 2022.
- B. Notice of the election was given in the time, form, and manner as provided by law; that candidates were nominated to fill the vacancies as required by law; that voting precincts were properly established; and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in the time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the City Charter and Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in charter cities.
- C. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 3011, on January 25, 2022, the City Council through the adoption of Resolution No. 2022-07 appointed Fernando Dutra as the elected City Council Member for District 4.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts was 8,819, of those ballots 7,988 were Vote-By-Mail, and 831 were in-person voting. Voter registration was 54,832, voter turnout was 16.08%.

SECTION 2. The names of persons voted for at the election for Mayor of the City for a full two-year term are as follows:

- Rolando Cano
- Joe Vinatieri
- L. Leon Savage

SECTION 3. The names of persons voted for at the election for Council Member, District 2, for a full four-year term are as follows:

- Mary Gorman-Sullens
- Michael Kazarian
- Octavio Cesar Martinez

SECTION 4. The name of the person elected via the nomination process for Council Member, District 4 for a full four-year term is as follows:

- Fernando Dutra

SECTION 5. The City Council does declare and determine that:


- Joe Vinatieri was elected Mayor for a full term of two years;
- Octavio Cesar Martinez was elected Council Member, District 2 for a full term of four years; and
- Fernando Dutra was elected Council Member, District 4 for a full term of four years.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk provided a Certificate of Canvass (Exhibit A), the number of votes cast by Vote-By-Mail and in-person voting; the number of votes given in City for each of the person's names above for their respective offices for which the person was a candidate on the ballot by precinct.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver a Certificate of Election signed and authenticated by the City Clerk and administer and execute the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California to each elected person.

SECTION 8. The City Clerk shall certify to passage and adoption thereof.
