Soil testing: In order to dump soil at our landfill we require **ALL RESIDENTS/CONTRACTORS** to get their soil tested before we can accept and allow you to dump. These are the tests we require: (Volatile Organic Compounds, Semi-Volatile Organic Compounds, Metals, Pesticides, Hydrocarbon Petroleum.) **SOIL ANALYTICAL RESULTS MUST BE EMAILED TO RRodriguez@cityofwhittier.org OR landfill@cityofwhittier.org**

Sampling frequency is as follows: Up to 1,000 cubic yards a minimum of one sample per 250 cubic yards shall be collected. From 1,000 cubic yards to 5,000 cubic yards a minimum of 4 samples for first 1,000 cy plus 1 sample per each additional 500 cy shall be collected. For more than 5,000 cubic yards a minimum of 12 samples of first 5,000 cy plus 1 sample per each 1,000 additional 1,000 cy.

***PLEASE READ CAREFULLY*:** To all **Residents/Contractors** please keep in mind that filling out this form and getting your soil tested **DOES NOT** mean you have the right or privilege to start dumping right away. It is a process for us. We must review all testing/paperwork before entry.

Rules/Times: The Savage Canyon Landfill accepts soil Monday thru Friday from 8:30am till 3:00pm. We **DO NOT ALLOW** any drivers/haulers to be waiting or staging in front of the landfill gates or on Penn St. before 8:30am. For all drivers hauling soil, make sure **ALL LOADS ARE COVERED**, drivers shall not be speeding coming, leaving, or on site at the landfill. **Residents/Contractors:** this form only allows you to dump soil, if any other material is found mixed in with your loads or if any of the rules are not followed, **THIS FORM WILL BE VOIDED AND WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANYMORE DIRT!**
CONTRACTORS ONLY: The following vehicles will not be excepted (belly-dump trucks, end-dumps, truck and trailer, also known as pup and trucks)

Savage Canyon Landfill is prohibited from accepting soil contaminated with hazardous materials / substances that may pose a threat to human health and safety or result in an adverse affect to the environment, e.g. contamination of groundwater. The City of Whittier must adhere to State regulatory requirements, as administered through the various boards and divisions of the California Environmental Protection Agency (Cal/EPA), to ensure materials, including soil, disposed at the landfills meet established acceptance criteria prior to disposal.

CERTIFICATION by the responsible manager(s) of the establishment.

"I certify, under penalty of law, that the soil I am disposing of (i) does not contain and is not contaminated with any hazardous materials/substances, as defined under any provision of federal, California or local law, (ii) meets established acceptance criteria for Class III landfill disposal, (iii) was taken from the address and site location(s), as indicated above and has not been combined with any substance from any other site or location, (iv) was tested by a State-accredited environmental testing laboratory and that such sampling was not conducted at an unauthorized location and (v) that all information submitted in this Soil Certification form is true and correct. Furthermore, I am fully aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and/or imprisonment under federal, California and local law."
