Hello - I am a homeowner on 13972 Midvale and for quite some time now all the homeowners on the street have unanimously requested parking permits for the street. We have met with the police, parking division, city planning etc. We have a real and dangerous problem in the evening and overnight hours with homeless, partiers, car clubs and people coming for the view. We frequently have cars parked with people, drinking, doing drugs, having sex. Our cars have been broken into, trash is left regularly. People will also use the culdesac for lunch breaks or other reasons during the day, parking illegally, blocking the mail, delivery trucks and any emergency vehicle that would need to come up there. It has gotten progressively worse with the rear side of Penn Park being controlled now and other view spots in Whittier being brought under control (re Rideout).

The power for us to have parking permits would be that they people coming to use our little street for the above named activity could be ticketed and that would be somewhat of a deterent to return. As of now anyone can park on the street and it has become unsafe. No parking signs are not an option as many of us have to park on the street for health and other reasons. Not all of us can park up or down very steep driveways.

We are asking that you please support whatever part of the plan that would allow greater flexibility in offering permit parking to residents on such a street as ours.
