


City of Whittier Liability Update



City's Position with CIPA

- Whittier's actuarial composite exposure:7.5% of the pool
- Whittier's actual exposure:52.5% of the pool
- Whittier pooled premiums increased from \$173k/yr. to over \$3M/yr. in last 10 years

Liability Exposure Review

California Insurance Pool Authority's (CIPA) Risk Management Requirements:

- Police Department's Administrative policies
- CIPA right to select & appoint defense counsel
- Arborist agreement
- Inspection of sidewalks
- Tree inspections
- Update policies related to liability

Parkway Tree Manual Removal Types



1. General Request – no recommended changes



2. Emergency – no recommended changes



3. Private Development – discussed at a later date



4. Diseased



5. Hazardous

Liability



Liability-Related Tree Removal Types

Current Description: Diseased/Hazardous - sewers, water mains, sidewalks

Current Process:

- 1. Temporary patching
- 2. Narrow sidewalk
- 3. Relocate sidewalk (including easement agreement)
- 4. Replace sidewalk
- 5. 30-day posting (appeal process applies)
- 6. Remove tree & replant

New Category: Justified Tree Removal Type

Recommended Description: liability and risk to public safety allows for immediate removal.

Recommended Process: Evaluation of the Risk Assessment Committee.

Risk Assessment Committee Members:

- Assistant City Manager
- Director of Parks, Recreation & Community Services
- Director of Public Works
- Director of Human Resources & Risk Management
- City Arborist
- City Attorney
