Street Sweeping Parking Prohibition

To request the establishment of "No Parking" provisions for street sweeping purposes on your street, please use the attached petition to gather signatures from your neighboring residents that will be affected by this parking restriction. "No Parking" provisions for street sweeping purposes work best on a block by block basis. The City requires that a two-thirds-majority of the affected residents support the establishment of the parking provision

In most cases, both sides of your street are currently swept on the same day on an every-other week schedule. To avoid confusion as to which week the street is to be swept, any parking restrictions established will be enforced on a weekly basis, regardless of whether the street is scheduled to be swept or not.

Following receipt of your petition, your request will be placed on the agenda of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Parking and Transportation Commission. The Commission normally meets the first Thursday of every month.

Notices will be delivered to all affected residents advising of the time and place to attend the public meeting of the Parking and Transportation Commission regarding the proposed establishment of parking restrictions for street sweeping purposes. At the meeting, after hearing public testimony regarding the proposed parking restriction, the Commission will determine whether or not to establish the parking restriction.

A two-thirds-majority of affected residents may request to have a parking provision removed no sooner than five-years from the date of action prohibiting. Any such request would be reviewed using the same process and evaluation criteria as staff uses for street sweeping parking provision requests. If it is determined that the existing posted signs serve no purpose, the signs will be removed at no cost to the individuals making the removal request.
